PARKING

On the day parking is £30 per car. If you have pre-booked, parking passes will be attached to your ticket email, please print these out and display on your dashboard to ensure a fast entry into the festival car parks. You may leave and re-enter the festival over the weekend.

PICK UP & DROP OFF

There is a pick up and drop off area located at the end of mouldridge lane. This will be clearly signpopsted as you enter the festival. This will be a track matted area that is easy to drive on & off of.

TRAINS

Our nearest train stations are: **Buxton**: approx 20 mins away by car/bus **Matlock**: Approx 17 mins away by car/bus Unfortunately, there are no public bus services that run to the site. However, we organise a shuttle bus that takes festival goers from these two stations to the festival site.

SHUTTLE BUS SERVICE

Shuttle bus tickets are £10 per trip.

BIG GREEN COACHES

All advanced Coach ticket purchasers will be dropped into the festival pick up & drop off point. You will then need to head to the pick up and drop off point on the Monday to get back on. You should receive separate, full information from Big Green Coach regarding your booking.

TRAVEL DISTRUPTIONS

If you are planning to travel to and from the festival via train services. Please be aware that strikes and distruptions may affect your journey.

There are potential distruptions due on **Monday 31st July**. Please check before you travel!

ARRIVAL INFORMATION

To enter the festival, you will need your ticket. These will be sent to you roughly a week before the festival.

Please print your e-tickets and have them ready to be scanned to reduce queue lengths at the Box office.

AGE RESTRICTIONS & ID 16 & Over

If you are 16 or over you may attend the festival on your own without an adult. However you will need ID to prove your age so that you can enter without a 21 year old. If you do not have this, you will need an adult 21 or over with you.

If you are 15 and under you need to be accompanied by someone 21 or over.

We accept the following forms of ID:

Passports / Drivers License / Provisional License / Citizenship Card

A Challenge 25 policy will be in place for all alcohol sales on site.

If you look under 25 and want to bring in alcohol or buy alcohol, you will need ID with you to prove that you are 18 or over.

Photocopies are accepted to gain entry but NOT to purchase alcohol at the bars. We do not accept photocopies of out of date ID.

GLAMPING & PITCH VILLAGE

CHECK IN & CHECK OUT

After collecting your wristbands from the box office, follow signs & head over to the Glamping & Pitch Village fields, located a short walk away.

Once you enter the field, please look for the reception and simply provide your order number and booking name and a member of the team will show you to your tent, pre-erected in the perfect spot and help you get settled in.

When you are leaving, please visit reception to let us know you are checking out. So we can sign you out of your structure & wish you well on your joureny home.






GATE & BOX OFFICE OPENING TIMES

GENERAL PARKING

What3Words: ///trifling.ketchup.seasons

Follow yellow traffic signs along the A5012 for public parking. Traffic coming eastbound from Matlock will be directed into the carpark via entrance gates along the A5012 onto Mouldridge lane.

Traffic coming Westbound from Newhaven will be directed onto Mouldridge Lane also.

Please avoid parwich lane where possible as this will be a dedicated route for Family parking only (Family wristbands only).

PRIORITY PARKING

If you have purchased priority parking, follow signs towards the front of the car park where you will find the priority car park in the field on the left, situated at the closest point to the festival gates.

ALCOHOL

Alcohol brought to the festival must comply with event regulations, anyone aged 18 and over can bring in limited amounts and types of alcohol. You may be asked for proof of age. Strictly no glass is permitted.

Alcohol will only be permitted on first entry to the campsite. You will not be able to exit and re-enter with more alcohol.

Personal Alcohol cannot be brought into the Arena, it will be on sale at Festival Bars subject to 'Challenge 25' ID policy.

Quantity Per Person

Up to 24 cans of beer/lager/ cider or alcopops (a mixture is fine)

Or

1 Bottle of Spirit (70cl Max — must be decanted. NO GLASS)

Or

2 Bottles of Wine (75cl Max - must be decanted. NO GLASS)



BBQ'S & FIRE

Personal camp fires are prohibited in the campsites and will be extinguished to protect the safety of everyone at the festival. Visitors are permitted to bring purpose built BBQs or small gas camping stoves. No disposable BBQs in the festival site or campsite. Disposable BBQs will be confiscated.

GAS CANISTERS

Gas canisters are allowed on site, although please be reasonable with how much you bring. Remember not to cook inside tents, and take extreme caution when changing camping gas. The Gas Canister limit is 250g.

AEROSOLS

Aerosols are allowed on site but please be sensible and respect your fellow festival goers. Misuse can result in ejection from the festival.

PYROTECHNICS

As of April 2017, changes in legislation under the policing and crime act 2017 means that anyone found guilty of possessing Pyrotechnics (Flares, Fireworks, Smoke Bombs etc) at a music festival could face up to 3 months in prison. Please do not bring them to the festival under any circumstances.

ADVERSE WEATHER

Y Not Festival is situated on greenfield land, as such conditions during adverse weather may become hazardous. Please ensure you bring appropriate footwear and clothing to cater for the possibility of wet, muddy and slippy conditions

SAFETY & SECURITY

Over the past few months we have been working to ensure Y Not will be an enjoyable and safe event for all. We hope you don't need the police, but if you do, police officers will be on site during the festival, alongside security staff, and whilst we hope you won't need their assistance they are here if you do need support. Please talk to officers if you do need help or advice, they will be happy to help you.

We want you to leave Y Not with great memories, new friends, and... all of your belongings.

Read the tips below from officers for staying safe at this year's event:

 Keep valuable items with you in a secure bag or inside pockets at all times.

• Campers are encouraged to put valuables in their sleeping bag with them when they go to bed.

• Stick with your friends — if you're with people you know and trust, the chances are you'll look out for each other. Festivals give you the opportunity to meet new friends but going off with people who you've just met may lead you into situations you don't want to be in.

- Moderate your alcohol consumption, if you overdo it you'll be less aware and less likely to spot dangers.
 - Keep an eye on your drink and never leave it unattended.

• If you're the designated driver for your journey home, remember that you could still be over the limit if you have too much to drink the night before you leave. So if you plan to hit the road the next day, stay sober the night before. No festival is worth losing your licence or your life over, and if you're over the limit the next day, the risk of a collision is huge.

HOW MUCH ALCOHOL CAN I BRING?.

Personal Alcohol cannot be brought into the Arena, it will be on sale at Festival Bars subject to 'Challenge 25' ID policy.

Quantity Per Person

Up to 24 cans of beer/lager/ cider or alcopops (a mixture is fine)

Or

1 Bottle of Spirit (70cl Max — must be decanted. NO GLASS)

Or

2 Bottles of Wine (75cl Max — must be decanted. NO GLASS)

CAN I RE-ENTER WITH MORE ALCOHOL?

Alcohol will only be permitted on first entry to the campsite. You will not be able to exit and re-enter with more alcohol.

CAN I BRING CHAIRS & GAZEBOS?

Chairs will only be allowed in the campsites, in the interests of health and safety we do not allow any chairs or tables in the arenas. Gazebo's will not be allowed at this years event as they pose a threat to health and safety in high winds & take up too much space campsites.

CAN I LEAVE THE FESTIVAL AND RETURN?

Yes — anyone can leave and come back as they wish, however, you can only bring alcohol into the campsites on your first entry. Re—entry with alcohol is not permitted. If you are planning on driving to and from the event each day please keep hold of your parking pass to show as proof of purchase. Please also remember to keep your wristband on! Please be aware gates close after 23:00 and open at 9:00 so you will not be able to re—enter in between these times.

WHEN DOES THE MUSIC STOP?

Arenas close at 3am on Friday / Saturday & 1:30am on Sunday. The latest venue is the Silent Disco which closes at 2.30am.

CAN I TAKE FOOD AND DRINK INTO THE ARENA?

You can take an empty bottle into the arenas, which you can fill up at one of our water points. You cannot take food into the arena, unless you have a medical reason to do so.

IS THERE A SHOP ON SITE?

There is a campsite shop in TheVillage Green area stocked with – soft drinks, energy drinks, slushies ice, ice lollies, cleaning medicines, tobacco, vapes, confectionary, breakfast items camping goods, wet weather items, sleeping bags, blankets, crisps confectionery, lighters, hygienic products & sanitary products.
