COOKIE NOTICE

What are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your computer by websites/applications that you visit. They are widely used in order to make websites work, or work more efficiently, as well as to provide us information for different purposes.

We use cookies on our websites/applications, which amongst other things, help us to improve your experience of our websites/applications and to ensure that it performs as you expect it to.

Who sets the cookies?

First-party cookies: When you visit our website, it asks your browser to store cookies on your device in order to remember information about you, such as your language preference or login information. Those cookies are set by us.

Third-party cookies: We also have cookies on our websites/applications that are set by third parties. These are cookies from a domain different than the domain of our website you are visiting. We use these third-party cookies for our advertising and marketing efforts.

Types of Cookies

We will now explain what cookies we use on our websites/applications and why we use them:

- **Strictly necessary cookies:** These cookies are fundamental in making our websites/applications work. They usually are activated in response to your actions and requests to our websites/applications, such as when you login, set privacy preferences, or fill in forms. You can block them via your browser, but some parts of our websites/applications will not work for you while such cookies are blocked.
- **Cookies not strictly necessary:** These cookies are not necessary for the proper functioning of our websites/applications. We collect such cookies when you consent to it. We ask for your consent in our cookie banner or in the websites/applications cookie settings, or in App permissions. Those are divided into the following subcategories:
 - **Performance cookies:** These cookies allow us to count visits and traffic sources so we can measure and improve the performance of our websites/applications. They assist us in understanding which pages are the most and least favoured, and how visitors move around the websites/applications. All information these cookies collect is aggregated and therefore anonymous. If you do not allow these

cookies we will not know when you have visited our websites/applications and will not be able to monitor its performance.

- **Functional cookies:** These cookies enable our websites/applications to provide functionality and personalization and they allow the websites/applications to remember choices you make (such as keeping you logged in across multiple sessions) and customised preference settings (e.g. text size). Functional cookies may also include cookies that enable you to share our content with your contacts via social media platforms. They may be set by us or by third party providers whose services we have added to our websites/applications. If you do not allow these cookies, then some or all of these services may not function properly.
- **Targeting cookies:** These cookies collect information about your browsing habits to make advertising relevant to you and your interests. They may be set through our websites/applications by our advertising partners. They may be used by those companies to build a profile of your interests and show you relevant adverts on other sites and social media. If you do not allow these cookies, you will experience less targeted advertising.

How long will cookies remain on my device?

The length of time that a cookie remains on your device depends on whether it is a “session” or “persistent” cookie.

- **Session cookies** last until you stop browsing. These are created temporarily. Once you close the browser, all session cookies are deleted.
- **Persistent cookies** last until they expire or are deleted.
